Mount Kisco Recreation:	Although tennis courts are not ideal for pickleball courts if that's what you have to work with, we recommend using a color for lines that doesn't stand out against the tennis lines but that also isn't too close to your court color. Recommend SportTech and Oval Tennis for painting lines.
Yorktown Parks and Rec:	Suggest using designated Pickleball Courts. Recommend SportTech and Oval Tennis.
Mount Pleasant Recreation:	Simplest, quickest and cheapest solution is painting lines on the tennis courts. Can use crank to lower tennis net or tighten belt in middle of net.
